Are you considering submitting an article to The Model Railroad Resource? We cover various aspects of scale O and scale S model railroading, as well as prototype railroading as a modeling subject. We welcome ideas for feature articles, video shorts, columns, or article submissions.

The Model Railroad Resource offers payment for first-time global print and/or electronic publication rights to freelance manuscripts and images under a Creative Commons license. This license allows you to distribute the work freely as long as the distribution remains free and you always provide a link back to our website. However, you may not distribute the work freely if you fail to include the URL of our site. Additionally, you may not use the work in a commercial publication without our permission.

Payment for articles

Many people submit articles to us and do not want/expect payment. They just want their information out there and freely available. Others do expect a payment and we fully understand that.

Our payments are based on number of words. A full article paying \$100 shall be 1500 words and over at our discretion. This will not include photo captions.

Shorter articles of 750 to 1500 words will be paid at \$50.

Payment is provided upon publication.

Submissions

We are vary lax with article requirements. We realize that most of you are not professional writers and may not know how to even get started. Think of it as sitting down with a good friend and explaining to them what you did and how you did it. Even if it's just random thoughts, put them in order and send them in. We'll work with you to flush out the article.

Explain your project using straightforward language. Remember, our articles are typically no more than five to six PDF pages not including images. Include plenty of photos and drawings, and make sure to label everything clearly. Use Word or or save as an RTF or PDF. Images may be embedded into the document, but we also need them sent individually.

Please also caption every photo. You may do this by providing a text caption or by labeling photos within the article as shown below.

We strongly recommend submitting digital photos in high-quality TIF or JPEG format, with a minimum size of 2400 x 1600 pixels and a maximum file size of 4 megabytes. Step-by-step photos should be in color, and each should have a caption.

The quality of your photos significantly impacts your article's success. Subpar photo quality can hinder your submission more than poor text. It's crucial to ensure your photos are clear and well-lit. If any photos in your submission are weak, consider redoing them (otherwise, we'll request redoing them before accepting your submission).

Never compromise on the quality of your article's photos. The top-rated articles typically feature the best photos. Avoid using an on-camera flash, as it results in poor-quality photos.

Technical notes: Photograph subjects in RAW format, if possible. Otherwise, use the highest-quality JPEG or TIFF setting.

Photos should be properly exposed and fill the frame with the subject matter. Provide multiple compositions for flexibility in publication design. When in doubt, send more photos rather than fewer.

For publication, images are displayed at 150 DPI. Maintain JPEG quality at 80% or higher to minimize compression artifacts.

Submit high-quality JPEGs, preferably larger than 2400 x 1600 pixels. Avoid correcting or manipulating photos unless necessary, and label altered images accordingly.

We'll format the article and send you a proof. You may then make any changes needed.

Prototype details (if relevant): Utilize photos and/or illustrations to illustrate the prototype you utilized. Photos can be in color, black-and-white, or both. Respect the ownership of photos you didn't capture yourself and seek permission from the photographer or source before including them in your submission.
